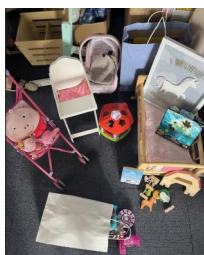


Splash Planet

Cheese Restaurants: I loved making a restaurant with Eva and making cheesecake, everybody loved it.

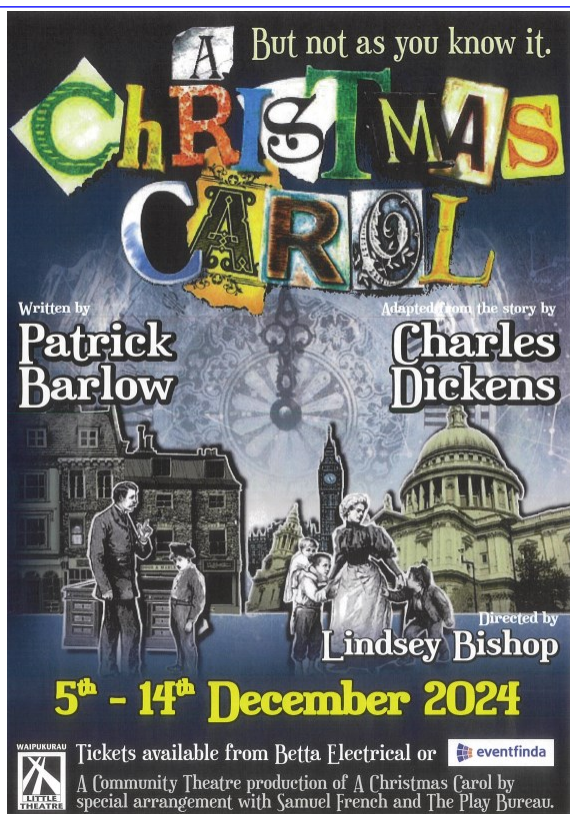
