
Nga Mihi mahana, warm greetings, Christine

Numicon originated in the U.K. and has been recommended by the N.Z. government as an approach to meet the new Mathematics curriculum standards. 'Numicon' provides a hands-on delivery of the NZ Mathematics Curriculum I am very excited to continue to use this amazing program to teach Math in the junior room. Yesterday the students demonstrated their understanding of numbers to 100 with the repeating pattern of ten.
