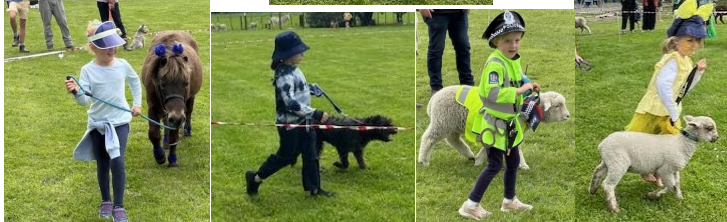
Pet Day
