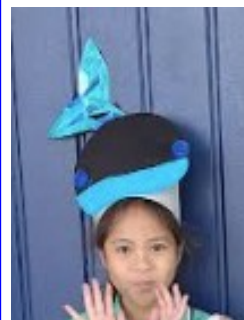
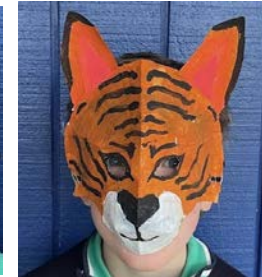
Kia ora Koutou Katoa, greetings to all Sherwood school and community families.

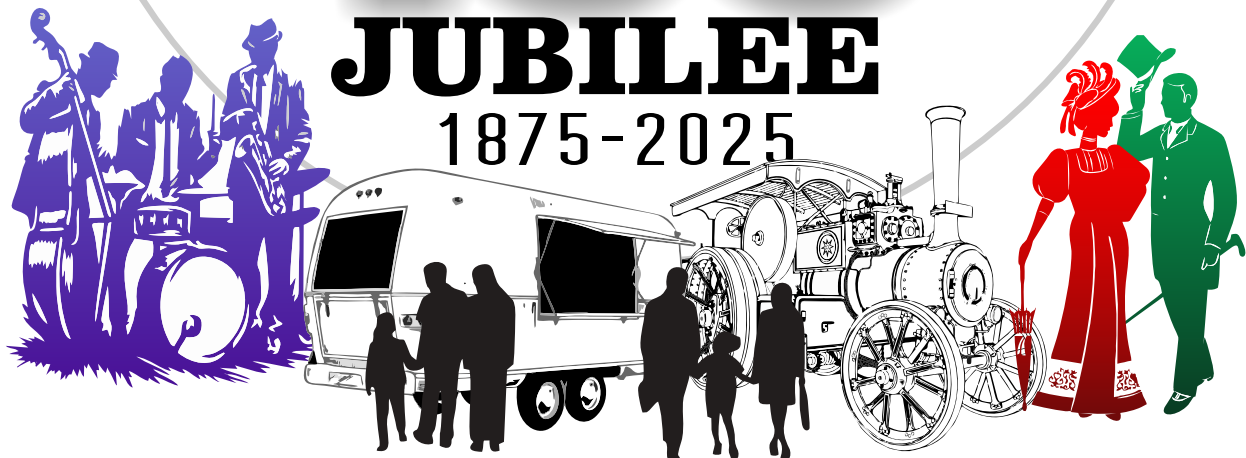
