Korero Mai - Building Strong Connections





I am pleased to introduce myself, My name is Mike Wilson and I have been on the board for the last 6/7 years, and chair for the past couple.


I grew up the Mangapokie road and attended Frasertown School in the late 80's. My children are 4th generation at Frasertown School.


