- 1:00pm onwards - Animal Parade, judging and presentation of certificates

FLOWER SHOW REQUIREMENTS

Rooms 1, 4 & 5: 1 saucer, 1 vase, 1 bowl and an assortment of flowers in a bucket or box.

PET REQUIREMENTS

1. No pets to be at school before 12:30pm please. Village children will be allowed to go home at 12:20pm to get their pets.

7. Please, to save everyone from embarrassment, no animals in season!
