Devotion: The Renewal of the Mind – Becoming More Like Christ
Romans 12:2 – “Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God’s will is—His good, pleasing and perfect will.”

At KingsView School, we desire to grow in wisdom and character, not just academically but spiritually too. Paul’s words in Romans 12:2 offer us a powerful vision for this kind of growth: becoming more like Christ through the renewal of our minds.

For families, this is a shared journey. As parents and caregivers, we model this renewal when we forgive quickly, speak kindly, and place Christ at the centre of our decisions. Our children watch and learn. They are shaped by the way we respond to challenges, love one another, and seek God’s will.

Let us encourage one another to be transformed—not conformed. As our minds are renewed, we will grow into the people God created us to be. And as a school community, we will reflect more and more of Christ to the world around us.
