Family Devotion - From Fearful to Fearless

Bible Reading: Luke 22:54-62 & Acts 2:14-41

Opening Question

Have you ever been afraid to do the right thing? Maybe you didn't stand up for a friend or stayed quiet when you should have spoken up.

Peter, one of Jesus' closest disciples, knew exactly what that felt like.

Peter's Fear (Luke 22:54-62)

On the night Jesus was arrested, Peter followed from a distance, trying not to be noticed. Three times people asked if he knew Jesus, and three times he denied it—just as Jesus had predicted. When the rooster crowed, Peter realised what he had done and wept bitterly. At that moment, fear controlled him.

Peter's Boldness (Acts 2:14-41)

Fast forward to after Jesus' resurrection. In Acts 2, we see a completely different Peter. Filled with the Holy Spirit, Peter stands in front of a huge crowd and boldly preaches about Jesus. He no longer hides—he speaks with courage! That day, 3,000 people chose to follow Jesus because of his words.

What changed? Peter encountered the risen Jesus, was forgiven, and was filled with the Holy Spirit. His fear turned into fearless faith.

Application: Growing in Courage

Peter failed, but Jesus still used him. We don't have to be perfect—God helps us grow.

The Holy Spirit gives us boldness. Just like Peter, we can ask God for courage to do the right thing.

Faith is greater than fear. When we focus on Jesus, fear loses its power.

Prayer

Dear Jesus, thank You for loving us even when we fail. Help us to be bold like Peter, trusting You and standing strong in our faith. Fill us with Your Spirit so we can live for You without fear. Amen.
