## Family Devotion: From Rebellion to Repentance – The Story of Jonah

**Key Verse:** “You are a gracious and compassionate God, slow to anger and abounding in love.” – Jonah 4:2

Have you ever tried to run away from something hard? Jonah did — God told him to go to Nineveh and warn the people to turn from their evil ways, but Jonah didn't want to. So he ran the other way!

God sent a storm, and Jonah ended up in the belly of a great fish. There, he had time to think and pray. He realised he couldn't outrun God. His heart began to change, and he promised to obey.

God gave Jonah a second chance, and this time he went. Amazingly, the people of Nineveh listened and turned from their wrong ways. God forgave them — just like He forgave Jonah.

But Jonah wasn't happy. He thought they didn't deserve God's mercy. That's when he said:

“You are a gracious and compassionate God, slow to anger and abounding in love.”

Jonah obeyed on the outside, but his heart still needed work. God cared about the people of Nineveh and Jonah's attitude.

### Family Questions:

Why did Jonah run away?

What do we learn about God's heart from this story?

Is there something hard God's asking you to do?

### Prayer:

Lord, thank You that You are loving, patient, and kind. Help us not just to obey, but to have hearts that want to follow You. Thank You that You never give up on us. Amen.

**This week's challenge:** If God's asking you to do something, don't run! Ask Him to help you do it with a changed heart.
