






The week that will be

Leaving the old life behind

Scripture: Matthew 4:18-22

"Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will send you out to fish for people." At once they left their nets and followed him. (Matthew 4:19-20)

Devotion

One day, Peter, Andrew, James, and John were busy fishing, just as they had done every day before. Fishing was their job, their way of life, and likely all they had ever known. But when Jesus walked by and called them, they left everything—boats, nets, even their families—to follow Him.

Why would they leave so quickly? They recognised that Jesus was offering them something greater than fish or a daily wage—He was offering them a new life and a new purpose. Instead of catching fish, they would be "fishers of men," bringing people to know Jesus.
