

Reporting on student progress and achievement is an important part of how we connect with our whānau, and HERO will make this even easier. Through the HERO app, parents and caregivers will be able to see their child's learning progress, goals, and

updates - giving you a clearer picture of what your tamariki are achieving and learning at kura. Our teaching staff are really looking forward to sharing this with you, and early in 2026 we'll provide all the information you need to access and use the app.

HERO will also manage school accounts. Over the past few years, we've been using MyKindo, which we know has been a bit tricky for some families. The great news is that with HERO, you'll now be able to make payments directly into the school's bank account. Families with outstanding balances will receive a statement this week - if you could make payment as soon as possible, that would be much appreciated.

As this is a new system, there may be a few small hiccups along the way - please don't hesitate to call or email the office if anything doesn't look quite right. We're very excited about this new chapter and can't wait to share HERO with our ŌHAU School community!

This term, students have enjoyed Rippa Rugby sessions led by Horowhenua Rugby, and a Padder Tennis session which was a big hit.


