Kia ora Roseneath Whānau

Thank you for keeping your children at home when they have cold or flu symptoms, and for doing a RAT just to be sure. We are noticing some more fatigue and illness than we usually do, your child might be a bit more fragile at home, needing more sleep, or just seeming a bit 'wiped out'. I know it's really tricky to judge whether your child is well enough to be at school, sometimes they are full of beans in the morning and have run out of energy by midday. We do contact you if your child has become unwell during the day so that you or another caregiver can collect them. We are experiencing cases of Covid in both Senior and Junior classes. We have RATs available at the office if you need any - just let us know.

A wee reminder of the guidelines around keeping your children at home following an illness:

- For Covid-19, the child (and any household contacts that need to isolate) need to stay home for 7 days, where the first day of symptoms or a positive test result is 'Day 0.
- If a child has been unwell with a respiratory illness other than COVID-19, they can return to school 24 hours after they have significantly improved and are behaving/eating normally.
- Following vomiting or diarrhoea, a child should be symptom free for 48 hours before they can return.

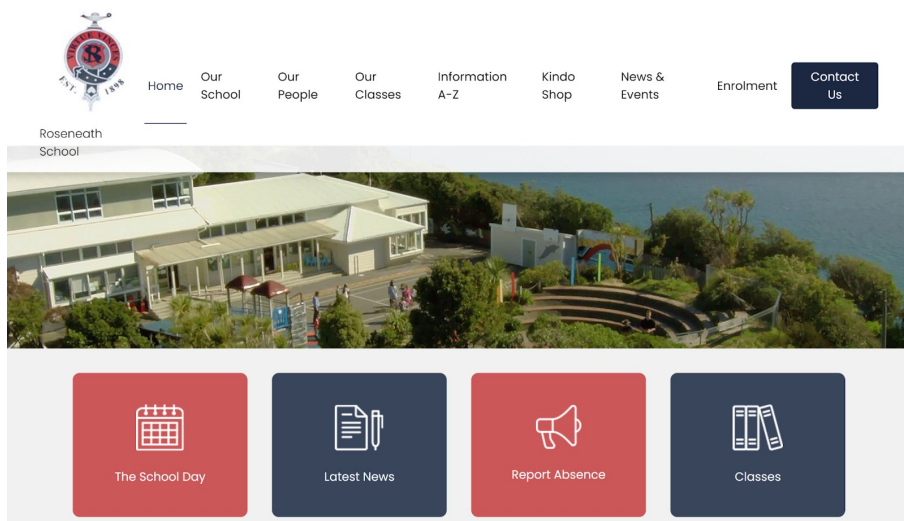

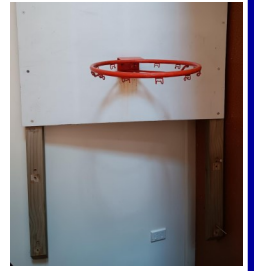
