Pita pit

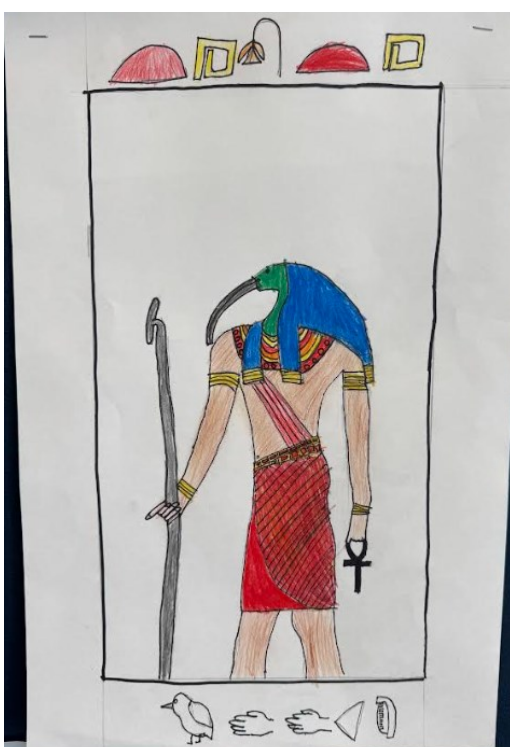
