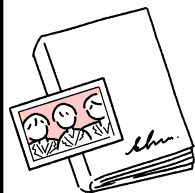
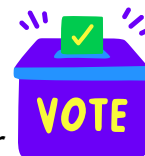


Our Term Three PB4L value we are focusing on is Wairua Pai – Having a good spirit

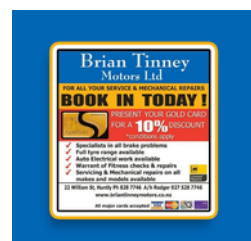
