Welcome to the 2025 School Year:

Since our first day back we have averaged around 94% attendance. That is brilliant. Most of our students have returned to school with a wonderful combination of excited expectation and enthusiasm. I have visited many classes and I am impressed with the attitude and settled behaviour of our children. Please take the time over the next week or two to meet your children's teachers. They will try to catch up with each of you over the next few weeks, perhaps in person, or if not then by text, Seesaw message, email, or phone call. If you or your child have any important information about your child's health needs or personal circumstances please make sure you make early contact with their teacher.

New Attendance Requirements:

As of this year, the government has imposed strict new rules on student attendance at school. The expectation is that all school-age students will attend school every day. There is an expectation that parents and whānau will contact the school on every occasion that a child is absent from school with an explanation as to why they are away. If we do not receive any communication from parents, or if the reason is not considered reasonable, the student will be marked as a truant. It is possible that the School Attendance Services may contact families or visit parents in order to support the student returning to school. We would appreciate your support with this new requirement.

If you are able to assist another family financially, please let us know. We would be truly grateful.




myKindo: changing an automatic payment


myKindo is our preferred method of payment. If you have an automatic payment set up going into our school bank account, can you please update this.












Driving safely near our school

MISSING LUNCH PROCEDURE

- Normal procedure when there is a problem with lunches is that the child would go to the office as soon as they notice a problem.
- If the food item is not located, we ask the office staff to ring the Lunch Provider.
- The provider will either refund the family or deliver any missed or incorrect lunches to the school immediately. This way the problem can be fixed quickly.
- We appreciate your help in ensuring your children are aware of this process.

LUNCH REMINDERS

Please avoid sending along fizzy drink, lollies and takeaway food in your child's lunch. Leave this as occasional treat foods for at home. Children who eat a healthy lunch are better able to learn and concentrate at school.

If your child does not have lunch, we do run a Lunch Club each day. Children without lunch need to see their teacher for a Lunch Club Pass and then they go to the hall to get a sandwich.

Parking around the school boundaries

We have some unhappy 'neighbours' around the school boundaries. At times, they are struggling to get INTO their own driveways, particularly around 3pm, as cars are blocking the entrance way. Please remember that cars MUST NOT be parked within 1 metre either side of a driveway. We thank you for your respect of others.

Going Home at 3pm

We have a problem at the moment with a number of students returning to school after 3pm, either on bikes, scooters, skateboards etc. The school is a busy place for teachers after school, with meetings going on most days, as well as parent meetings and onsite after school care etc.

We respectfully request that once students go home, that they do not come back until the next day! There is no supervision after school, and we have had some near misses with children on bikes etc.

If your child has a sports practice, they need to go home and come back at the appropriate time.

At Westbrook we use the Seesaw digital portfolio to share your child's learning journey with you. Please take the time to go on to it regularly and view or comment on your child's work. The children love to see their parents taking an interest in what they do at school. Reporting to parents about their child's progress and achievement is also done through Seesaw. If you have not yet joined Seesaw, please do so as soon as possible. Your child's teacher can assist you with this if you need help.
