#### Colin's Korero

The Treaty of Waitangi: You may have heard or read that our current government is looking to remove any obligations or content in schools about Te Tiriti o Waitangi. Our current position, like most schools in New Zealand, is quite clear. Since 2007 we have been required, under legislation, to write a Strategic Plan for a three-year duration. Our current Strategic Plan and our Concept Curriculum, which sits alongside the Strategic Plan, require us to include references that relate to supporting the principles of the Treaty. This Plan was approved by the Ministry of Education. We intend to continue to uphold the requirements of this Plan, including the references to Te Tiriti o Waitangi.

**Kinetic Sand:** You may also have heard that Kinetic Sand was imported into NZ, which contained asbestos. A small sealed container of this sand was held in a cupboard, on the stage, in the hall. This was owned by the Kelly Club. The owner of Asbestos Eliminators came to school on Monday, removed the sand for burial, and gave our school clearance to continue as normal.

**Year 6 Camp**: Our Year 6 students and staff enjoyed three days of fun and adventure last week at the Tui Ridge Outdoor Adventure Park. The team was supported by several very enthusiastic and capable parents. On behalf of the school, I would like to thank the parents and staff who gave up their time to ensure that our students had a wonderful time.

Whether you're new to Kindo or already using it, managing school payments is easy.




#### **New to Kindo?**

- · Browse the school shop, purchase and check out.

#### Already have a Kindo account?

- Log in to your Kindo account
- Navigate to 'My Details'
- Select your student and add membership
- Select new organisation from the dropdown list
- Browse the school menu, add items to your cart, and check out.





## Parking around the school boundaries

We have some unhappy 'neighbours' around the school boundaries. At times, they are struggling to get INTO their own driveways, particularly around 3pm, as cars are blocking the entrance way. Please remember that cars MUST NOT be parked within 1 metre either side of a driveway. We thank you for your respect of others.

#### Going Home at 3pm

We have a problem at the moment with a number of students returning to school after 3pm, either on bikes, scooters, skateboards etc. The school is a busy place for teachers after school, with meetings going on most days, as well as parent meetings and onsite after school care etc.

We respectfully request that once students go home, that they do not come back until the next day! There is no supervision after school, and we have had some near misses with children on bikes etc.

If your child has a sports practice, they need to go home and come back at the appropriate time.

#### **SEESAW DIGITAL PORTFOLIOS**

At Westbrook we use the Seesaw digital portfolio to share your child's learning journey with you. Please take the time to go on to it regularly and view or comment on your child's work. The children love to see their parents taking an interest in what they do at school. Reporting to parents about their child's progress and achievement is also done through Seesaw. If you have not yet joined Seesaw, please do so as soon as possible. Your child's teacher can assist you with this if you need help.
