Teacher Only Day: Thank you for your understanding and support this week with regard to our Teacher Only Day. Our staff all took part in a whole day of training to learn more about the new Structured Maths Curriculum, which we are currently implementing.

Strike Day: At this stage, it looks like we will be going ahead with our Strike Action next <u>Thursday</u>, <u>October 23</u>. This is not something we want to do, nor do we take this action lightly. Our determination to have an Education System that caters to the needs of all of our students is very strong. We believe that your children deserve better, and we are all collectively standing up for your children. We are also determined to have a well-resourced Education System, including one that recognises our contributions to a successful outcome for the students we teach.

ShakeOut Day: This Thursday, October 16, is National Shake Out Day. At 9.30 am, we will all practice our procedures for keeping safe during an earthquake. The whole country will be engaging in this exercise at the same time.

Loud Shirt Day: This Friday is Loud Shirt Day. This is a nationwide fundraising campaign to help raise money for The Hearing House and The Southern Cochlear Implant Programme. We are each encouraged to bring a gold coin to school and wear a loud shirt to show our support for the students impacted by hearing loss









Classes for 2026: We have begun the process of drafting our class lists for 2026. We spend a great deal of time on this, as we are determined to ensure that our students are placed in a class where they have the best possible opportunity to enjoy success. We try to balance each class in terms of gender, ability levels, ethnicity, and personality types. We also ensure that each student has at least one or two other students in the same class they get on well with. Parents and caregivers are welcome to contact me if you have important information about your children that may help us with this exercise. Please note that we do not consider parent requests for specific teachers. We ask that parents respect our collective ability to make the best possible decisions about which class children are placed in and who their teacher will be. If you intend to be moving out of our area, or your children are changing schools for whatever reason, we would appreciate being notified, as this has a significant impact on our decision-making.


School Closed Thursday 23rd October


Primary teachers, primary principals, support staff, kaiārahi i te reo, therapists and Ministry of Education field staff and support workers have all voted to take strike action together on 23 October!

Across the motu, we are all driven by the same thing: we're frustrated by the lack of progress in our negotiations and we're deeply worried about the future of education in this country. You don't attract or retain good people to work with tamariki if you don't provide fair pay and good conditions.

And you don't support tamariki by prioritising tax breaks for tobacco companies over investment in education.

We know New Zealand's parents and tamariki depend on us every day. When their children go to school, they need us there to support them. But right now, we're finding it increasingly hard to do this important work. And the Government is ignoring our calls for more learning support and to uphold Te Tiriti o Waitangi in education.



We have sun hats in our house colours for sale at through KINDO for \$15 each. Please also ensure your child has sunscreen on before they come to school and if you wish them to reapply it during the day, please make sure they have it with them in their school bag.

Drop Off and Pick Up

The children have adapted to our safe system for dropping children at school and picking them up after school. This is generally working well, however we still have some concerns with drivers leaving cars unattended and parking in our drop off/pick up zone. We appreciate your support with following our systems.

Please remind your children each day where you will be picking them up at 3pm.

The five Loading Zone spaces on Malfroy Road will remain available for parents to safely drop off and pick up only. Staff will continue to supervise these sites until further notice

Where possible, please encourage your children to get in and out of the car on the footpath side, not the road side. Ensure your child is safely secured with their seatbelt before leaving the car park area/loading zone.
