School Closed - Strike Action

You may have seen in the news that educators across Aotearoa are preparing to take part in a historic national strike on Thursday, 23rd October. For the first time ever, principals, teachers, support staff, and Ministry specialists will stand together to call for better support in schools, fair pay, and the resources our tamariki need to thrive.

This action is about more than just pay. Health, education, and emergency services are the backbone of our communities—and right now, they're all underfunded and under-resourced. Our schools aren't struggling because of the people working in them. They're struggling because the system isn't being properly invested in.

In education, real investment means having teacher aides in every classroom, valuing educators with fair and secure work, upholding Te Tiriti o Waitangi, and protecting quality early childhood education. These changes would make a huge difference—not just for our tamariki, but for the wellbeing of our whole education system, and for those of us leading it.

At Westbrook School, our priority is always the safety and well-being of our students. On the day of strike action, our kura will be **closed for instruction**, so we ask whānau to please make alternative arrangements for your tamariki.

We know this may cause disruption, and we truly appreciate your understanding and support. This decision hasn't been made lightly—it reflects the seriousness of the challenges we're facing in education, and the urgent need for change.

Discos Tonight: This is a final reminder that we are hosting two Discos tonight, October 22, for our students. The first, for children in Years 1 to 3, begins at 5.30 pm and ends at 6.30 pm. The Senior Disco, for students in Years 4 to 6, begins at 7 pm and ends at 8 pm. All students must be dropped off and picked up by an adult.

Drop Off and Pick Up

The children have adapted to our safe system for dropping children at school and picking them up after school. Variety - the Children's Charity has received \$50,000 of funding for tamariki and rangatahi in Rotorua!



Our Individual Grants (IG) programme provides one-off funding for something your child needs. The good news is, your child doesn't have to be part of the Kiwi Kid Sponsorship programme to be eligible for an Individual Grant.

An Individual Grant pays for a one-off need such as...

- Everyday essentials (such as clothing, car seats and shoes)
- School costs (including uniforms, stationery, activity fees, school camps, and school trips)
- Digital devices for school (for children aged 8 or older)
- Extra-curricular activities (like sports lessons, music lessons, club fees, and uniforms)
- Medical fees (covering doctor's fees, prescriptions, glasses, medical, and mobility costs)
- Beds and bedding (beds, cots, bedding packs)

You can apply for an Individual Grant if you have a **valid Community Services Card** and your **child is aged between 0-18.**

Going Home at 3pm

We have a problem at the moment with a number of students returning to school after 3pm, either on bikes, scooters, skateboards etc. The school is a busy place for teachers after school, with meetings going on most days, as well as parent meetings and onsite after school care etc.

We respectfully request that once students go home, that they do not come back until the next day! There is no supervision after school, and we have had some near misses with children on bikes etc.

If your child has a sports practice, they need to go home and come back at the appropriate time.



If your child is unwell or can't attend school, log onto Lunchonline, click on to the order for this day-you will see a cancel button. This must be done before the providers cut off time for ordering (most providers are 9am on the day of delivery, but some vary - check with your school).
