Edge Portal or App

We are moving towards reports being uploaded to a portal or app. You will find the instructions for signing into this below. On the Portal/App you will be able to see your child's attendance, a digital copy of their reports, and your school account. You will be able to view your contact details, you can then let the office know if they are not correct. You can also use the App to notify absences if you wish. We will eventually be able to send out notifications via this as well. This term you will get a paper copy of your child's report and be able to access it digitally.

A big thank you to all those parents who are continuing to let us know why their child is absent. This makes our reporting to the Ministry much easier. If your child is feeling anxious about coming to school, please chat to your child's teacher in the first instance or see Deana or myself if you need any extra support.

We are moving towards our reports going out on our edge Portal and App

How do I log into the edge Portal?

- 1. Click on the following link Edge Caregiver Login
- 2. Type in the email address you have supplied to the school. Click the 'Reset password' link and an email will be sent to you that includes a link allowing you to create your own password.
- 3. Use email address and new password to enter Portal



How do I log into the edge Mobile App?

- Downloaded from either Play Store (Android) or App Store (iOS). Search for MUSAC edge.
- 2. Once installed, make up a 4 digit pin.
- 3. Type in the email address you have supplied to the school. Click the 'Reset password' link and an email will be sent to you that includes a link allowing you to create your own password.
- 4. Use email address and new password to enter the edge Mobile App.

Once you have entered the Portal or App you should be able to see your child's:

- Contact details
- Attendance
- Student reports (only the end of 2022 will be published at this stage, this terms report will be published at the end of Term 2)
- School payments (there is only one bill payer loaded per family if you wish to add more please contact Sarah at the office)

(If you have more than one child you will get the opportunity to select each one individually)

If you have any problems with getting this to work, do not panic over the long weekend. Feel free to pop in and see Mrs Drake and she can help you work through it before the terms reports go out.
