From the Principal...

Kia ora Whānau,

Ka nui te mihi ki a koutou - greetings to you all.

The end of term is coming around rather quickly and this term, like most others, has flown by. For me, this means that my time at GPS is coming to an end after nearly nine years here. Looking back, it certainly seems a lot less than nine years!



In the last week our Year 5 classes have been to their camp at Raincliff and had an enjoyable time away. In our last newsletter, I noted the effort that is put into camps by staff and the support that we receive from parents and whānau. This applies to not only camps, but other events both outside and within the school and general support for our school programmes. This is much appreciated by the staff - thank you!

Please note that we expect children to be present and part of the conversation about their learning. While this may be a bit daunting for younger students, it is something that they can become more confident with over time.

On Wednesday 5 April our Home and School Group is organising a fun run obstacle course on the field for our students. We are asking children to bring a tee shirt in the colour of their Whanāu Group. We are aiming for a 1pm start and parents / whānau are most welcome to attend.

Louise has been a wealth of knowledge over the last five years and I know I speak for the school community when I say that we have all appreciated what she has done for our school.
