- Support Staff in Schools' Collective Agreement

We expect formal notification from NZEI Te Riu Roa on Monday 20 October (three days' notice before the proposed strike).

If the strike goes ahead, our school may be closed for instruction as we may not have enough non-striking staff to safely open.

A more formal notice will be sent via email closer to the time, but I wanted to give you early warning so that you can make childcare arrangements for Thursday 23 October.


