School Closure Likely

Sadly, the government and our Unions have not made any headway towards an agreement for educators in schools. As a result your School Board tabled a motion to close Tairangi School on the 23rd of October unless an agreement can be reached before then.

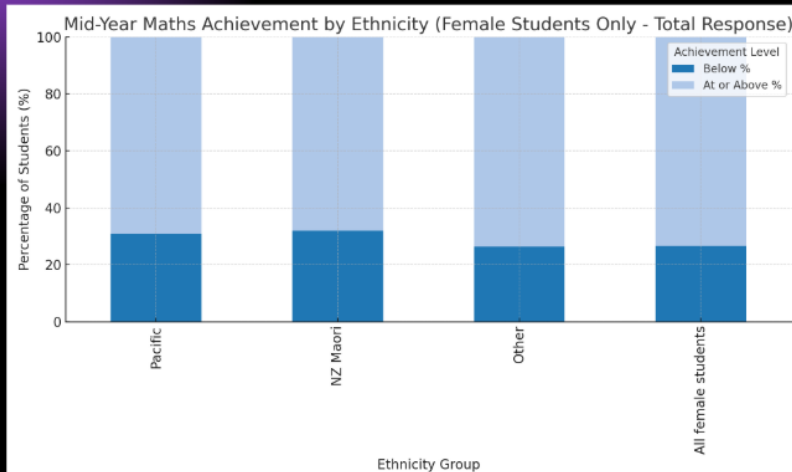

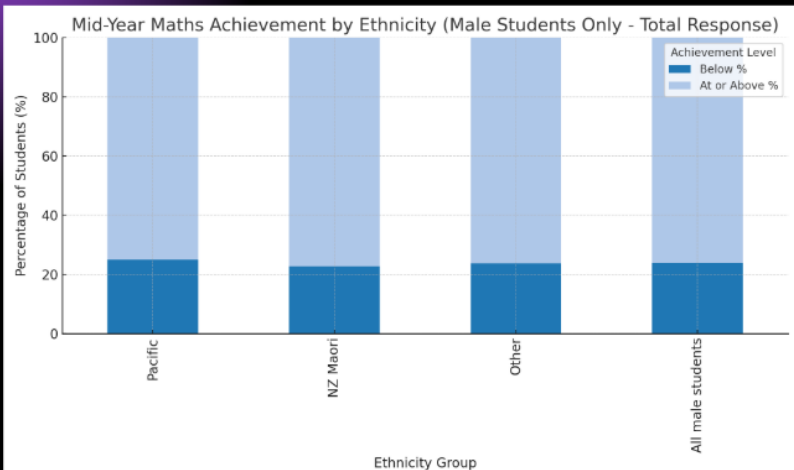

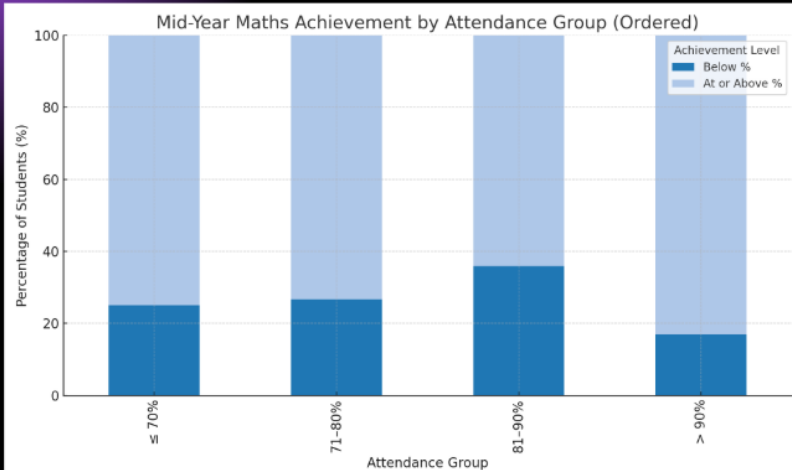
