We will be going through activities with the children towards the end of the term and this evening is an opportunity to first introduce it to you as parents. Please keep an eye out for this as it is an evening not to miss.

Finally - you will see over the remainder of this term that the classes are being updated with new whiteboards, wall coverings and lighting. Your child's class may be disrupted for a week but the results will be well worth it.

Forms have been sent home to register your child along with Lunch and Apparel forms. Could we have these returned to the school office by Monday 28th July.






