Structured Literacy

In 2021, our school started their journey with the Better Start Literacy Approach. This structured literacy approach, a systematic and evidence-based teaching approach to ensure early literacy success for all our tamariki is used in Years 1-3. We are certainly seeing the impact of the professional learning development that has supported our teachers to implement this approach in their classrooms.





We recently put in an application to the MOE for funding to extend our professional learning development into Years 4-8, and it is with great enthusiasm from our teachers to hear that our application has been successful. Across Term 2, Miss Wallace, Miss Johnstone, Mrs Settle and Mrs Dassler will be working alongside the University of Canterbury, as they complete their micro-credential on this literacy approach - an integrated classroom literacy approach for fostering oral language, reading and writing success in children.

Swimming

We have had an amazing swimming season for our tamariki, but with the cooler weather, more students arriving without their togs, than with their togs, the swimming season has now come to an end.
