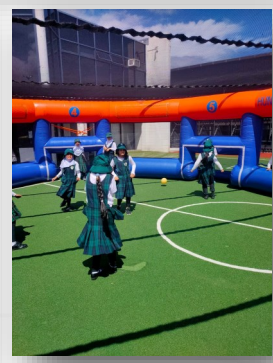
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HungerBall Day:

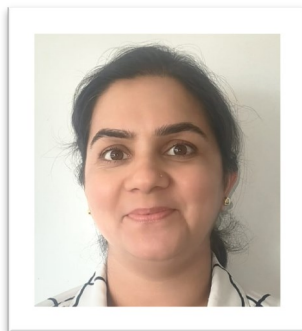

9. What makes you happy when you come to school?

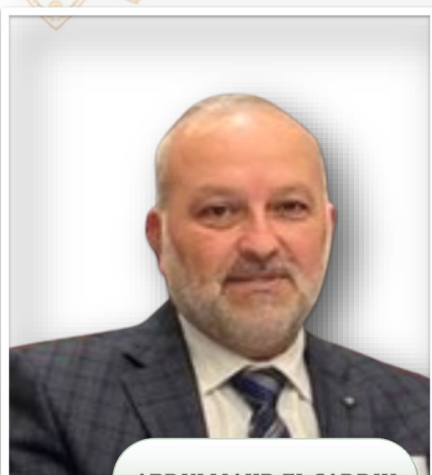
I know that I am living my childhood dream and sharing my knowledge with children.
