Thank you to the families who attended the annual Iqra School Iftar nights on March 13 and 14 last week. These were wonderful events and the school was really grateful for all the support from our families and community. The community raised just over \$30,000 on these two nights! This is a huge amount and the school is very appreciative for the support. This will be combined with the \$25,000 raised in previous years to make a combined \$55,000 towards the proposed playground. Thank you to those who were able to make a contribution! Measles Guidance

Measles can cause significant disruption to education settings from kaiako and ākonga absences due to prolonged illness and isolation or quarantine requirements.

While it is the responsibility of public health services to manage measles outbreaks, they need your support to keep kaiako and ākonga safe.

We believe in the importance of supporting these projects and urge everyone to participate in these noble humanitarian initiatives and to share them with their friends and family.



Women's Iftar Night – March 13, 2025










Men's Iftar Night – March 14, 2025






