



### **PET COMPETITION**

Registrations are now closed.

Please make sure that all pets come tethered or caged and bring your own water bowls. Please bring pets to school from 12:30 onwards - not before.

Animals will be judged from 1pm.

St Anthony's Bush Ag Day Teams - registration forms are available from the office and are due back by 3pm Friday, 24 October 2025. Bush Ag Day is the only competition where St Anthony's registers a school team.
