The staff have other commitments outside these house and school is not a babysitting service. If an unavoidable delay occurs, notice to the office is required ASAP with an alternative pick up arrangement provided to the school.

#### **Notifications from the Office**

Please be aware that if your child is not in the class at the time the roll is called or if they arrive late and do not sign in at the office, our system arranges for a message to be sent to the caregiver requesting an explanation. It can occur that a student may be in the bathroom or in a music lesson at the time of roll call but please respond to them message with either an explanation of their absence or if they should be at school.

Additionally, all head knocks at school are assessed for concussion regardless of its degree and a notification will be sent to the caregiver, we encourage you to keep an eye on them at home also as sometimes concussion can be delayed.
