ERO Visit and Upcoming Special Character Review

We were pleased to host the Education Review Office (ERO) at school during Week 1 of this term. The visit went very well, and we received both positive feedback and some valuable suggestions for areas of school improvement. We look forward to sharing the final ERO report with our community in the coming 2–5 weeks. Looking ahead, we are preparing for our Special Character Review in Term 3. This review, led by the leadership team at NZCPT (New Zealand Christian Proprietors Trust), focuses on how well our school is upholding and expressing its Christian character in all aspects of teaching, leadership, culture, and community life.

Striving for Strong Attendance

At KingsGate School, we are enthusiastic about reaching the government goal of having at least 80% of our students attending school regularly, defined as attending with five or fewer days absent across a term. In Term 1, we're proud to share that our Year 9 students achieved 92% regular attendance, and Year 4 students reached an outstanding 95%. Congratulations to both year levels on this fantastic achievement! We now challenge all other year groups to match or exceed these high standards as we continue to prioritise learning through consistent, everyday attendance. Our overall regular attendance rate for Term 1 was 78%.
