From the Principal

I also want to take a moment to talk about the importance of parent participation at school events. Our High School students are involved in a rich and meaningful Service Learning curriculum that is central to who we are at KingsGate. These events provide our students with opportunities to live out our values, grow in leadership, and bless others. However, many of these events are going ahead with very little support from our parent community. I regularly hear from parents during interviews that they are more than willing to support the school, and I believe this, but I would love to see that support more clearly in action. When concerns do arise, it's vital that we work together through our school's Concerns and Complaints Procedure. Children, especially younger ones, can be very observant but not always accurate interpreters of what they see or hear. If your child raises an issue, let them know they've been heard—but also help them (and us) by reaching out to their whānau teacher first. That's the best way to ensure we all have the full picture and can work together toward a positive outcome.

School is a partnership, and I deeply value your role in shaping our shared journey at KingsGate.








Prayer Points
