Biodiversity is needed for ecosystems because without it we would struggle to survive. From classification to famous scientists such as Carl Linnaeus, this writing has it all!

Biodiversity is vital for life because it makes everything unique and provides us with clean air, food and medicine. Being a scientist is just one of the jobs that you, yes you, can get. Scientists help us and protect life on our planet.

Carl Linnaeus was an 18th Century scientist who made a system for classifying living things. This system helped to avoid confusion when discussing plants and animals. This system is called the Binomial Naming System. (It uses Latin words) It helps scientists better understand and protect living things.

In conclusion, biodiversity is important for life on earth, classification helps scientists understand and organise living things, and Carl Linnaeus was famous for his Binomial Naming System.
