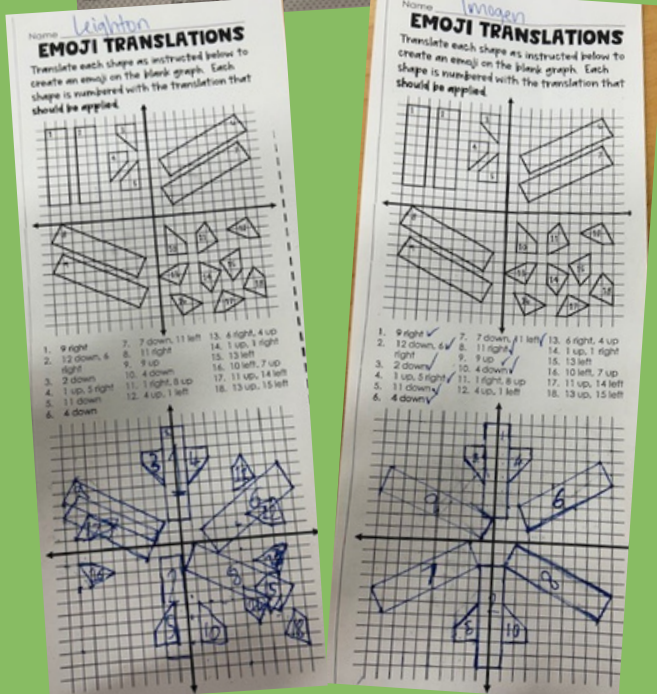
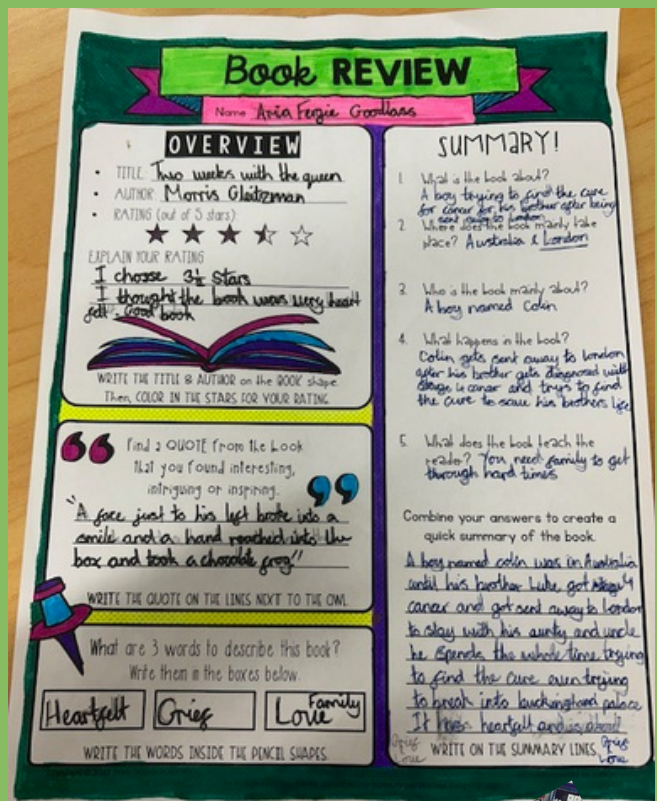
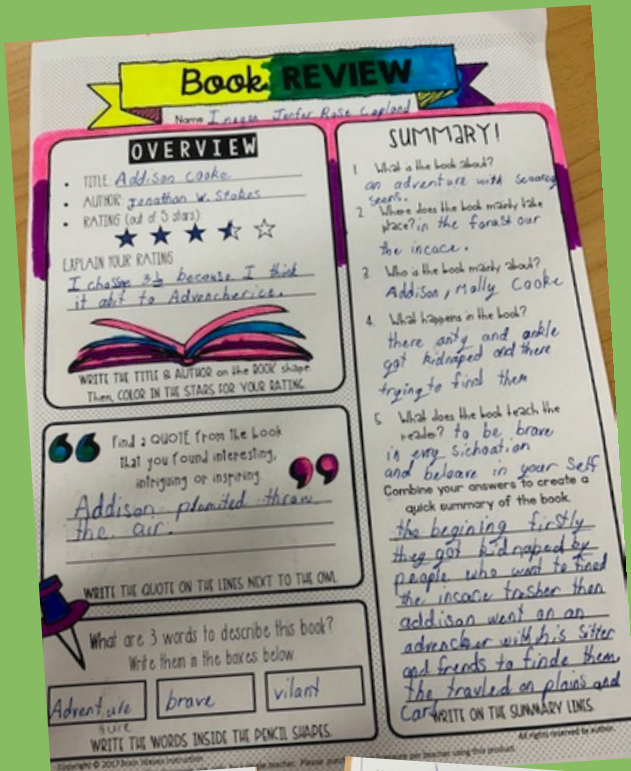
ROUGH RIDGE NEWS

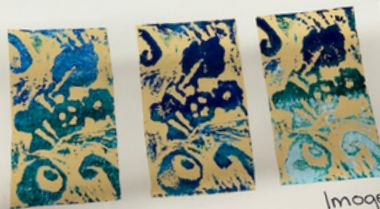

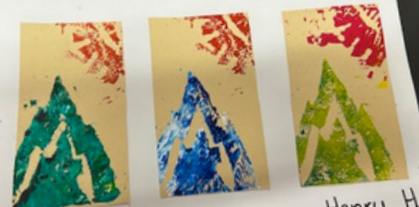
