Kia ora,

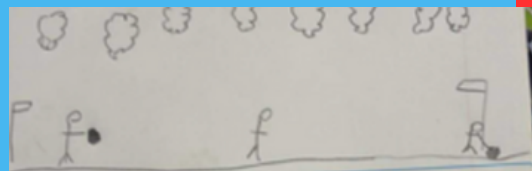
I loved hearing the stories about the Matariki bonfire. It sounds like the children thoroughly enjoyed themselves. Thanks to all involved in organising the evening.

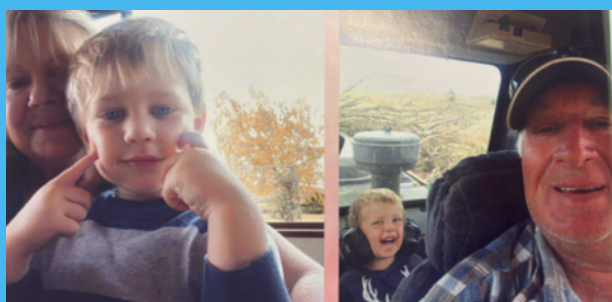
My Cousin Tia-Lea

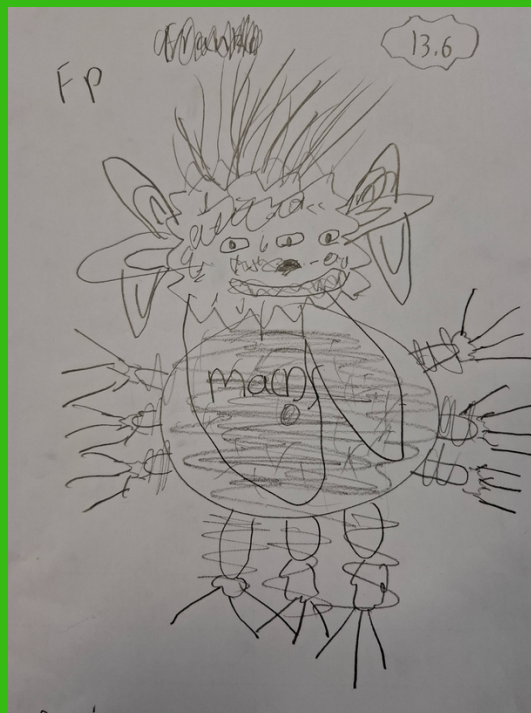
