On Thursday afternoon we have three four year olds visiting us. We look forward to seeing Ollie, Amelia and Tully.


We went out to see our veggie garden this week. It was super exciting to see our radishes, peas and carrots already sprouting. Thanks to Annette who has been helping water them.
