This is a term-time only position, and the rate of pay will be in line with experience.

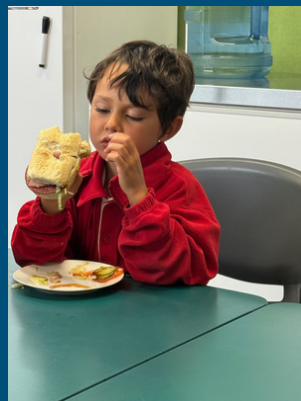
