As part of the **Ministry of Education's Attendance and Engagement Strategy**, three additional attendance measures have been introduced and will be reported on by schools:

- Absences remaining unexplained at the end of each week
- Learners with 5 or more full days unjustified absence in a term
- If action has been taken for learners unjustifiably absent for 5 or more full days

The first action we will be taking when students reach 5 days of unjustified absence per term, will be to send an email or note to the parents/caregivers, highlighting the fact that their child has missed 5 days of school during the term.

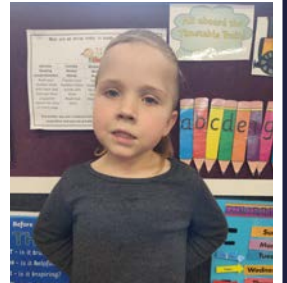
