Room 3 has been learning about road safety and how to keep ourselves safe. Here are a few things we have learned that we want to share...

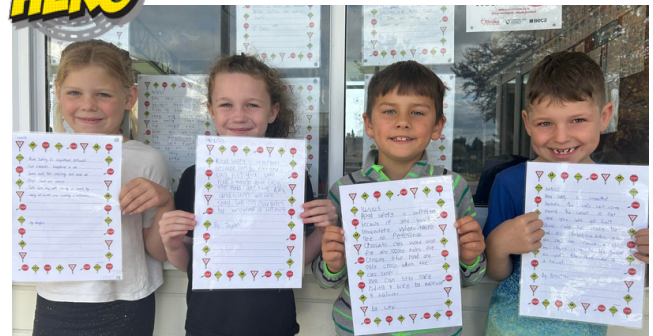
Georgie says "Road safety is important because car crashes happen a lot."
