As a friendly reminder, it's a legal requirement for all children aged 6 to 16 to be enrolled and attend school regularly, ensuring they don't miss out on vital learning and social connections. We understand that absences are sometimes unavoidable. If your child will be away for one or more days, please inform us each day of the absence and provide the reason.



Consistent attendance helps your child to thrive academically and socially, and we are here to support you in making this a priority. If you have any concerns, big or small, please do not hesitate to connect with your child's teacher in the first instance or Jo McCreanor, our Deputy Principal. Your partnership is invaluable!

Remember..... Regular attendance at school is *no more than 5 days of absence* in a term.

Curriculum and Reporting Update

Your child's mid-year report will be available to view on the **Hero app** from **Thursday 26 June**. This is our first time using Hero to report to families, and we're excited to share your child's progress with you in this new format.

The report will include:

- A progress graph showing whether your child is working towards, at, or above their expected curriculum and year level
- Information on their engagement in learning for reading, writing, and mathematics

- A general comment on their learning
- Their attendance to date

How to view your child's report:

- 1. Log in to the Hero app or visit https://go.linc-ed.com
- 2. Click on your child's name
- 3. Click on 2025 Report

Please note: reports will not be printed and sent home. If you need help accessing Hero, please contact your child's teacher or see Ashley in the office. We will be holding our 3-way conferences in Week 2 of Term 3, on Tuesday 22 July and Wednesday 23 July. These meetings will be a great opportunity to discuss your child's learning progress and goals in more detail.
