



Tuition Agreement

THE PARTIES TO THIS CONTRACT ARE:

PARENTS OF THE INTERNATIONAL STUDENT (“PARENTS”) _____

AND

ONERAHI SCHOOL (“THE SCHOOL”)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The school will provide tuition services to the “Parents”.

The above parties acknowledge that _____, the student, is the recipient of the tuition services but is not party to this contract if under 18 years of age.

2. The school will provide tuition in accordance with the Education (Pastoral Care of International Students) Code of Practice 2021.
3. The “Parents” appoint and authorise the Principal of the School (or such other person as may be appointed by “The School” to carry out the Principal’s duties to:
 - a) Receive information from any person, or authority concerning the student for medical, educational and welfare purposes.
 - b) Provide consents in respect of any activity carried out and authorised by “The School”.
 - c) Receive financial information relating to the student for immigration requirements.
 - d) Provide consents that may be necessary to be given on the student’s behalf in the event of an emergency, e.g. accident / surgery, where it is not possible to contact the “Parents”.
4. “The School” shall use its best endeavours to ensure the safety, health and well-being of the student whilst on school property; and as far as practicable, ensure that the student lives in a safe environment but shall not be liable for:
 - a) Any damage or harm caused to the student or the student’s property arising out of the student’s accommodation arrangements or while attending the School or outside of normal school hours.
5. Refund of Tuition Fees will be made as per the School Refund Policy.
 - b) In order to be eligible for any refund the “Parents” must apply in writing to “The School” giving a reason for seeking a refund.
 - c) If you change your mind before coming to New Zealand (Student has not attended Onerahi School at all), full tuition fees will be refunded. “The School” reserves the right to deduct the administration fee(s) as advised in the current Fees information.
 - d) If the “Parents” wish to cancel the student’s study after coming to New Zealand (Student has attended Onerahi School as an enrolled student), but before the second half of your course, a refund will be made less the administration charge; costs to the school already incurred for tuition at the current rate; the proportion of the per annum Government Levy the school is required to pay.
 - e) If the “Parents” wish to cancel the student’s study after coming to New Zealand (Student has attended Onerahi School as an enrolled student), but after the second half of your course no refund will be made except in the case of:
 - Return home because of student’s serious illness.
 - Return home because of death or serious illness of a close member of the student’s family.
 - Compassionate grounds at the discretion of Onerahi School. In the cases under New Zealand law, the school must retain amounts to cover costs already incurred. The balance will be refunded. Medical evidence must be provided.



- f) No refunds will be made to the “Parents” whose student is asked to leave “The School” because of misbehaviour, poor attendance, violation of the New Zealand law, including traffic laws.
 - g) No refunds will be made to the “Parents” who wish to transfer the student to another school in New Zealand.
 - h) No refunds will be made to “Parents” whose student returns home for any reason other than the student’s serious illness or death/serious illness of a close member of the family.
 - i) No refunds will be made to the “Parents” who acquire Permanent Residence for the student or whose parents acquire a Work Visa/Permit, after having enrolled at “The School”.
 - j) No refunds will be made to the “Parents” who fail to obtain the correct immigration study visa.
6. The “Parents” agree that the student will comply with the School Rules and regulations.
 7. The “Parents” agree that the student will not use alcohol and drugs.
 8. The “Parents” agree that the student will not drive or purchase any motor vehicle.
 9. The “Parents” must advise the Principal of any change of address, or contact details.
 10. The “Parents” acknowledge that personal information of the student or the “Parents” held by “The School” can be used for the purpose of application for tuition, provide tuition and associated services provided by the school and as a means of communication with the “Parents” with that information as “The School” sees fit.
 11. All disputes will be in terms of New Zealand Law and held in New Zealand Courts.
 12. **Medical and Travel Insurance:** International students must have appropriate and current medical and travel insurance to cover the students travel to and from New Zealand; and within New Zealand; and if the travel is part of the course, outside New Zealand; and medical care in New Zealand including diagnosis, prescription, surgery, and hospitalisation; and repatriation of expatriation of the student as a result of serious illness or injury, including cover of travel costs incurred by family members assisting repatriation or expatriation; and death of the student, including cover of travel costs of family members to and from New Zealand; and costs of repatriation or expatriation of the body and funeral expenses.
Eligibility for Health Services: Most international students are not entitled to publicly funded health services in New Zealand. If the student received medical treatment during his/her visit they may be liable for the full costs of that treatment. Full details on entitlements to publicly-funded health services are available through the Ministry of Health, and can be viewed on their website at www.moh.govt.nz.
Accident Insurance: The Accident Compensation Corporation provides accident insurance for all New Zealand citizens, residents and temporary visitors to New Zealand, but you may still be liable for all other medical related costs. Further information can be viewed on the ACC website at www.acc.co.nz.
 13. **Immigration:** Full details of visa and permit requirements, advice on rights to employment in New Zealand while studying and reporting requirements are available through the New Zealand Immigration Service, and can be viewed on their website at www.immigration.govt.nz. (Immigration Act 2009).
The “School” will ensure that the student/s have immigration authority to study. Any known or suspected breaches of student visa conditions will be reported to Immigration New Zealand (INZ).
