

The end of the school year is approaching quickly. Please read this end of year organisation so you are aware of all upcoming events.

End of Year Organisation Friday 5th December:

Yr 6 Fun Day at Waipu Cove. Children will travel by bus.

Wednesday 10th December:

Yr 6 students and any known leavers will get their reports.

Thursday 11th December Prizegiving

Our prizegiving will start at 10:45 in the MPR. The whole school will be involved for the first part of the prizegiving, where each teacher will give out CARE certificates to four students from their class. Known leavers who are not Yr 6 students will be acknowledged.

After this, the junior classes will leave prizegiving, and return to their classrooms with their teachers. Known leavers parents can choose to take their children home, or they can stay at school. All other children need to stay at school. Prizegiving will continue for our Yr 6 students. All Room 1 - 4 students will stay for the whole prizegiving.

At the conclusion of the prizegiving, all Yr 6 students will meet in front of Room 1 and 2 for a group photo.

After the group photo Yr 6 students and their parents are invited into Room 1 and 2 to have a shared lunch. All Yr 6 students are asked to bring a plate.

At the conclusion of the lunch, school life at Maungaturoto School ends for our Yr 6 pupils. Yr 6 pupils go home with their parents.

Thursday afternoon Yr 1 - 5 pupils: At the conclusion of prize giving Yr 1 - 5 children will go to lunch, before meeting in the MPR to find out their 2026 class. After classes are called out, children will go to their 2026 class with their 2026 teacher. Children will go back to their 2025 classes at 2:15 to get their bags. Reports and confirmation of 2026 class placements will be given to the children and sent home with your child on Thursday afternoon.

Friday 12th December: School is open until 12:30p.m. Buses and collected, and walking lines will leave at this time. Children will get a lunch snack pack to take home with them. There will be NO Afterschool Care on Friday 12th.
