

Athletics Day

Kia ora whanau,

Below is information and an attached estimated programme for our track events for Athletics day (11th November). On Wednesday 12th November we will hold our field and fun events. Parents are welcome to come along and watch on both days. On Tuesday the 11th the PTA will be selling sausages, moosies, and juices.

On Wednesday the 12th November we will hold Field and Fun events. This event runs from 10:40a.m. - 12:45p.m. Parents are welcome to come and watch this event. Field events are not part of the champion points but first place in high jump and first and second place in long jump and shot putt for children 8 yrs and above will have the opportunity to participate at Bream Bay athletics.

Parents are welcome to come along and watch on both days. On Tuesday 11th, the PTA will be selling sausages, moosies, and juicies.

Over the next three weeks your child will be running heats in their age groups to find out which heat they will participate in on Athletics Day. This is done during class time. Everyone participates both during class time and on athletics day in the sprints. Finalists for the 200m and 400m events will be determined in class time. If you want to know what day your child's 200m and 400m class final will be, please contact your child's teacher as all these run offs are being held on different days between 28th October and 6th November.

The 700m race is an open event for 8+ years and the run offs were held on Tuesday the 4th of November. Children will be told who is in the 200m, 400m and 700m final races.

In order to gain championship points your child must place in the championship races. The more they enter, the better their chances are of a certificate, as points are given out per race.
