

Athletics Day

Kia ora whanau,

Below is information and an attached estimated programme for our track events for Athletics day (11th November) and track and fun events on Wednesday 12th November, Parents are welcome to come along and watch on both days. On Tuesday 11th, the PTA will be selling sausages, moosies, and juicies.

We will hold our field events and fun events on Wednesday the 12th November. This event runs from 10:40a.m. - 12:45p.m. Parents are welcome to come and watch this event. Field events are not part of the champion points but first place in high jump and first and second place in long jump and shot putt for children 8 yrs and above will have the opportunity to participate at Bream Bay athletics.

Over the next three weeks your child will be running heats in their age groups to find out which heat they will participate in on Athletics Day. This is done during class time. Everyone participates both during class time and on athletics day in the sprints. Finalists for the 200m and 400m events will be determined in class time. If you want to know what day your child's 200m and 400m class final will be, please contact your child's teacher as all these run off are being held on different days between 28th October and 6th November.

On Tuesday 4th November, weather dependent, we will hold our 700m heat at morning tea time. This will allow us to find our finalists for athletics day. This event is for 8 yrs +over and is an open optional race. The first six children will be the finalists. Children will be told who is in the 200m, 400m and 700m final.

In order to get championship points your child must place in the championship races. The more they enter, the better their chances are of a certificate as points are given per race.
