BOARD CORNER

At the recent School Board meeting the following was discussed:

- The new Relationship and Sexuality Curriculum document was discussed at length. The Board would like to further discuss this with teachers, then parents. Ms West and Mrs van Mil will be attending a Ministry of Education update on this later this term.
- Thank you Home and School who are going to fund two handrails for the pool to enable swimming lessons to operate more smoothly for your children.
- Ms West presented the attendance data for the first two terms this year. As a School Board we were alarmed at the number of children who are regularly absent which ultimately affects their learning. The Ministry of Education has asked schools to monitor, and maybe report, children whose attendance is at 75% or less. Weekly attendance information will be sent home to those who present as concerns.
- Dates were set for the 2024 school year.
 Students will start on Wednesday 7th February 2024. Term dates are as follows:
