#### **Attendance**

Regular attendance at school is critical to achievement and Aotearoa New Zealand's future. Our attendance is lower than other comparable countries and attendance levels have been falling since 2015. This drop was evident before the Covid-19 pandemic, and attendance continues to fall.

At Waitomo Caves School, we continue to celebrate regular attendance.

Here is further information following last week's attendance notices that went home on Friday.

Children who arrive at school on time are marked as P, for present in our Schools Management System (SMS). Children who arrive to class between 8.30am to 8.40am are considered L, for late. If children arrive at school after 8.40am they are coded in the SMS as E, with an explained reason for their absence which the Ministry of Education deems as an absence. We enter the time of arrival and consider them as P, present while it's coded E, explained. The Ministry set the coding and this links to our SMS. The Ministry also deems lateness as a form or truancy.
