<u> Team Tahi Newsletter – Week Ten</u>

Recently in Room One we have been learning about the solar system. We have made a model for our classroom wall of the sun and the eight planets. In groups of three we used paper mache to cover balloons in plenty of layers. We then had to research what the planets looked like and what they are made of so we knew what colours to paint them.

Our model of the Solar System is not to scale because if our sun is the size it is (approximately 18cm in diameter) then Mercury would have a diameter of 0.6mm and the distance from the sun to Neptune would be 576.28m!

We are now currently writing an information report on a planet of our choice.



Some Interesting facts that we have found out:

•Uranus rotates on its side because it was hit by a large object earlier in its history.

•The Kuiper Belt is located around the outside of our solar system beyond Neptune. It is mostly made up of icy objects.

•The Asteroid Belt is between Mars and Jupiter. It contains millions of asteroids.

•The Oort cloud is outside the Kuiper Belt on the edge of our solar system. Also made up of icy objects.


