Navy Blue shorts or track pants – Not Black or other variations please. Socks are expected to be as 'plain' coloured as possible. Please no bright coloured knee high socks.


All footwear must have a closed toe. Sneakers or something else comfortable for running in. Sandals and flip flops are not acceptable for our school environment.


