Waikāka Combined Districts Athletics Information

Athletics Day - 23 February 2024

Postponement Day Monday 26th of February

re is some helpful information about Athletics Day:

- All students will need to be transported to and from Athletics Day (which is held at Waikaka School) by their parents as **there is NO bus running on this day.** Everyone is to arrive by 9am for a welcome and directions on where to go for the different events unless your child is running the 800m. This will be on the back field.
- The 800m race is the first event of the day to be run at 8:30am. Please let your students know to arrive at a good time as we will not wait for them. All those competing in the back field may enter. Only students from 9 years upwards are eligible to qualify for Eastern (if they meet the time and are placed in the top 3).
- Students are to wear shorts or tights with the Knapdale School top which they will be given next week and gym shoes. They will also need to bring warm clothes and a jacket in case it gets cold.
- When your child arrives, they need to find their classroom teacher who will give them their Athletics Day card. This needs to be handed to Miss Croad at the end of the day.
- If your child leaves during the day, they need to inform their classroom teacher.
- Students will need to bring a drink bottle and a decent packed lunch. The Waikāka School PTA will have a tent with items available for morning tea, and a BBQ for lunch.
 - o Baking \$3
 - o Sausages \$3 or \$5 for 2
 - Coffee/Tea/Milo \$3
 - OR baking/drink combo \$5
- All parents/whanau parking is in the paddock beside the school and there is access via a gate to the back field. You will not be able to park directly in the school grounds by the school front.
- The 5, 6 and some year 7 year olds will be competing on the front field in the morning with modified athletics activities. They will come and join us out the back for running finals in the afternoon.
- If you are feeling athletic, there might be a parents running race at the end of the day (this will be time dependent). Good luck!
- Due to the nature of the day, all of our staff are involved in either running events or other roles
 during the day. Students will be moving around the events in their age groups so please remind your
 child to be responsible and show the school values at all times. Parents will also need to be
 responsible for their own child's behaviour and ensuring they are in the correct places during the
 day.
- We are incharge of running two events on the day and are looking for around 4 amazing parent helpers to help us on the day. If you are able to help us please get in contact with Raewyn or Paige.

Whakatauki: Mā te huruhuru ka rere te manu. (Adorn the bird with feathers and it will fly)

- If the day is postponed, we will inform you via our schools facebook page.
- Eastern standards must be reached before selection. Top 3 for track events, top 2 for field events.
