Keeping our Tamariki Safe

Police are continuing to receive complaints of illegal and inconsiderate parking around the school and across driveways. On Thursday, Police observed several cars parking on broken yellow lines, across driveways and in the no stopping area. Please remember:

- No Parking on yellow lines and in the no parking area - this is strictly prohibited.
- Do not double park and drop your child off.
- There are plenty of car parks
- available around the surrounding streets.
- Park and your child can walk the short distance to school.



If vehicles are found parked illegally, Auckland Transport and Police will issue a stationary infringement notice. Police have already issued in excess of 20 tickets, up to \$750.


