# ST MARK'S FEAST DAY (observed on 25 April)

Go into all the world, and proclaim the Gospel to every creature, alleluia. Mark 16:15

St. Mark, the Evangelist, the author of the second Gospel, was the son of Mary whose house at Jerusalem was the meeting place of Christians. He was baptised and instructed by St. Peter. In about the year 42 A.D. he came to Rome with the Prince of the Apostles. There at the request of the faithful he wrote his Gospel about the year 50 A.D. His Gospel is a record of St. Peter's preaching about Our Lord and pays special attention to the head of the Apostles. The Gospel was written for Roman Gentile converts. It rarely quotes the Old Testament, and is careful to explain Jewish customs, rites and words. It excels in portraying the emotions and affections of both Christ and His hearers. St. Mark preached in Egypt, especially in Alexandria and was martyred there. (www.catholic culture.org)

# **General reminders**

#### **Winter Uniform**

Winter uniform items can be worn from the start of Term 2. Please ensure all uniform items, especially jackets and jumpers are clearly labelled. We would appreciate all children being in winter uniform from Monday 12 May.

### **Before School Drop Off**

Many children are being dropped off far too early in the morning with the waiting area at the front of the school packed by 8.15am. There is no supervision on-site until 8.30am, however a member of the leadership team is usually out front from 8.25am. Please note: school officially starts at 8.50am. Dropping your child between 8.30 and 8.45am allows plenty of time to prepare for the day ahead. If you require early morning supervision, SKIDS is available.

#### **TERM 1 ATTENDANCE**

Letters have gone to families of children who have had less than 80% attendance this term. You may be aware of the Prime Minister's attendance target as too many children in NZ are not attending school regularly. There are always genuine reasons to keep your child at home such as medical appointments, illness, or bereavement, however, the minister is keen to see all travel and holidays (unless of an urgent nature) taken during term breaks. Children should be at school every day - there is a direct connection between school attendance, academic achievement, and pro-social behaviour. We do not want any child to miss out on important learning opportunities and experiences.
