## **✓** Attendance

The Ministry of Education is currently monitoring school attendance very closely. It is important that we are informed of any absences, along with the reason. Below are the main attendance codes we use at Okoia School:

- M Medical (e.g., illness or medical appointment)
- T No contact received regarding the absence
- J Justified reason (within school policy)
- E Explained but not justified (e.g., holiday taken during term time)
- Q Approved period of learning from home
- U Student stood down (1-5 days, reported to ENROL as per MOE guidelines)

## Open Door Policy / Issues or Concerns.



At Okoia School, we operate an open-door policy and encourage open communication. To ensure all our children have a safe and enjoyable playtime, we've recently introduced separate playground areas for our students:

- Years 1-3 (Juniors)
- Years 4-8 (Seniors)

This change has come in response to feedback from some of our younger students, who were finding the older students' play a bit too rough—even though they enjoyed playing together.

The separation helps ensure that play remains fun, safe, and appropriate for each age group. We'll continue to review this as needed, but early feedback shows that students are adapting well and enjoying their new play spaces.
